GENERAL DESCRIPTION

General Contractor seeks Mechanical/Electrical Quality Control and Commissioning employee for Bethel based project. Prior Mechanical/Electrical QC or engineering experience desired. Responsible for project Quality Control/Quality Assurance/Commissioning. Provides Quality Control direction to field personnel, including reviewing work quality, safety, and monitoring performance. Responsibilities include assuring all contractors and subcontractors comply with engineering standards and specifications. In addition, this individual makes certain that all engineering, surveys, inspections, etc. are complete and comply with the project.

3. Assist in the resolution of quality control issues.
